Please note my appearance in the above caption matter on behalf of Sabrina P. Salomon, Esq. My client, Ms. Salomon, was out of the country and her flight was delayed yesterday causing this response to be one day late.

The complaint filed against Ms. Salomon by Mr. Jimenez stems from legal advise given to Mr. Jimenez at a hearing that took place on December 7, 2012. During that hearing it was my client's strong legal judgment that it was in Mr. Jimenez best interest to accept offer by opposing counsel to pay for only half of the legal fees incurred by his ex-wife because the presiding judge had clearly indicated he would charge Mr. Jimenez with total amount requested by opposing counsel if no agreement was reached.
